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- Oversee agency financial planning and fiscal integrity. In collaboration with Finance staff, develop a budget and monitor monthly financial performance. Maximize efficiency in operations.
- Develop a strong team by fostering potential, motivating, and inspiring trust. Provide guidance and coaching to staff members.
- Strengthen the organization's community presence and overall visibility. Foster collaborative relationships with community partners such as government officials, other human service providers, local and diocesan pastoral leaders, and donors.
- Provide information and support to the CCS/L Board of Directors. Serve as an ex-officio member of the Board.

Position Qualifications

Minimum of 5 years of executive management or other high-level leadership experience. Experience in human services and/or the non-profit sector is a plus. A bachelor's degree from a four-year college or university is required; a graduate degree is preferred. Must be an actively practicing Catholic in good standing.
